#### Weather Notifications:

Our JMC message center uses the phone number identified as your "primary" number to make the phone call or text message if we are delayed or cancelled due to weather. To check your primary information, use your login or call the office to make sure your contact information is up to date. It's also a good idea to have an **alternate plan** in place for your child if early outs should happen, please let us know if you have not done so already. Thanks!

**Remember:** Our policy for going outside at recess is if it's **above ten degrees**, factoring in wind chill, *we will go outside*. Coats are recommended when the temperature is below 60 degrees. Please be sure your child is dressed to go outside; warm clothing is a must for them to be on our buses and playground.

#### Nurse Notes ~ Reasons to Keep Your Child Home

Children should stay home if any of the following are present:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Upset stomach
- Skin rashes or sore, any lesion on the skin that is draining
- Excessive coughing
- Sore throat
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache
- Flushed face
- Contagious illness, such as strep throat or chicken pox

\*\*Please keep your child home for 24 hours after symptoms (including fever) are gone. If your child's temperature can be kept under 100 degrees only by giving him/her acetaminophen or ibuprofen, your child should stay at home. We've had an increased number of kids with head lice. Please check your child for head lice and please treat it before the child comes back to school.

Second semester will begin January 3<sup>rd</sup>. Per our supply list your student is being asked to bring 2 boxes of Kleenex for their classroom each 9 weeks. Thank you in advance for helping out!
